At Lichfield, the 19th day of July in the year of the Lord 1588

Before master Zachariah Babington &c.

On which day appeared one Richard Edge and took oath that he is special messenger sent to appoint a proctor in the name of Elizabeth Plante relict of one Laurence Plante of the parish, when he lived, of Leeke, deceased, to renounce administration of the goods of the said deceased &c. And he appointed Thomas Sympson, notary public, proctor to the effect abovesaid &c.: who, appearing in person, exhibited his proctorship &c. and made himself a party on behalf of the said Elizabeth &c., and in the name of the said Elizabeth he renounced administration of the goods of the said deceased &c. and craved that this renunciation be admitted and enacted &c. Wherefore the lord admitted the renunciation &c. And then

Administration of the goods of the said Laurence Plante was committed to the aforementioned Richard Edge, brother-in-law of the said Laurence, sworn in form of law, to administer to the use and behoof of William Plante and Elizabeth Plante, children of the said deceased, being under age &c.

Tuition of the said William and Elizabeth Plant was also committed to the aforementioned Richard Edge and to one Ralph Gardner, their kinsmen, and of their portions of their goods during their minority &c.
