*Know all men by these presents, that we Mary Plant of Bradshaw in the parish  
of Leeke in the county of Stafford widow and Joseph Austen of Fould in the  
county aforesaid husbandman are held and firmly bound to Richard Raines,  
doctor of laws, commissary-general of the Reverend father and lord in Christ,  
lord Thomas by divine permission lawfully constituted bishop of Lichfield and  
Coventry, in £200 of good and lawful money of England, to be paid to the same  
Richard Raines or his certain attorney, executors, administrators or assigns: to  
which said payment well and truly to be made we bind ourselves and each of us  
for himself for the whole and jointly, our heirs, executors and administrators,  
firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals. Given the 23rd day of the month  
of March in the year of the Lord 1682, and in the 34th year of the reign of our  
lord Charles II, by the grace of God king of England &c.*

Mary, Hannah & Martha Plant n<sup>r</sup>ral & lawfull Children of y<sup>e</sup> dec<sup>r</sup>ed being in  
their minority is by the abovenamed D<sup>r</sup>: Richard Raines Committed and Granted  
doe & shall well and Conveniently Educate Foster and bring up the s<sup>d</sup>  
Children with sufficient & convenient meate Drinke Lodging and Appell  
meete and decent for their Estate and Calling Dureing their minority And doe  
also pay or Cause to be payd unto then all such Su<sup>r</sup>me & Su<sup>r</sup>mes of money  
Legacyes & Portions of Goods as to them shalbe due by the last will and  
Testam<sup>t</sup>: of the s<sup>d</sup> Dec<sup>r</sup>d And lastly does and shall upon her owne pp<sup>r</sup> Costes &  
Chardges save Defend and Keep harmeles the s<sup>d</sup> D<sup>r</sup>: Richard Raines and all  
other officers and Minister<sup>s</sup> in y<sup>t</sup>: behalfe authorized for Committing and  
Granting the s<sup>d</sup> Letters of Tuic<sup>r</sup>on Then this Bond to bee voyde or else to  
stand in full force & vertue:
