Know all men by these presents that we, Dorothy Plant of the parish of Leeke in county Stafford widow, Richard Plant of the same farmer and William Rogers of the parish aforesaid farmer, are held and firmly bound to William Walmisley, bachelor of laws, commissary-general of the Reverend father and lord in Christ, lord John by divine permission lawfully established bishop of Coventry and Lichfield, in £200 of good and lawful money of England, to be paid to the same William Walmisley or his certain attorney, executors, administrators or assigns: to which said payment well and truly to be made we bind ourselves firmly, and each of us for the whole and together, our heirs, executors and administrators, by these presents, sealed with our seals. Given the 11th day of the month of April in the year of the Lord 1700.

The Condic'on of this obligac'on is such, That if the above Dorothy Plant and Richard Plant To whom the Tuition and Educac'on of William Plant a minor sonne of Richard Plant dec'ed being in his Minority is by the abovenamed **William Walmisley** comitted and granted doe and shall well and conveniently Educate foster and bring up the said W^m– Plant with Sufficient and convenient Meat, Drink, Lodging and Apparell meet and decent for his Estate and calling dureing his Minority & doe alsoe pay or cause to be Paid unto him all such Su'me or Su'mes of money Legacy's and Porc'ons of Good^s as to him Shall be die by the Last Will and Testament of the said Dec'ed And Lastly doe and shall vpon their own proper Cost and Charges, Save defend and keep harmless the said William Walmisley and all other offic^{ts}. and minist^{ts}. in this behalfe authorized for comitting and granting the said L^{ts}. of Tuition Then this Bond to be voyd & of non effect or else to remaine in full force & vertue
