Impr' That whereas my nephew William Plantt of the stonecliffe hath heretofore giuen mee a bond for y^e payment of Ninetey Pound^s to be disposed of by my last will which sd su'me of ninetey pound^s I dispose of as followeth Item my will and mind is & I giue & bequeath to my nephew John Plant son of Robert my Brother Robert the su'me of twenty pound out of which sd su'me of twenty pound in the first place my Exsecutour herein hereafter mentioned shall pay & discharge such debt^s as my sd Executour shall att my decease stand ingaged or bound for y^e abouesd John Plant my nephew & what remanes in y^e hand of my Exsecutour as aforesd shall be due & payable to y^e sd John att y^e end of one whole yeare after my decease Item I giue & bequeath to Rich' Plant my nephew son of my Brother Rich' Plant the sume of four pound^s & ten pound^s more to be Equally devoided among the brothers & sisters of the last mentioned Rich' Plantt which Legacies as afores'd are to be payed att the end of one whole yeare next after my decease Item I giue & bequeath to Rich' Plantt my nephew son to my Bro: Thomas the su'me of twenty pound^s allsa I giue Sarah Whisstone wife of Thomas Whisstone the su'me of tow pounds & allsoe I giue to Ann Cleaton wife of Ralph Cleaton y^e su'me of tow +pounds+ Item I giue to Will' Plantt & Rich' Plantt sones of Rich Plantt my nephew the su'me of four pounds to be Equally devoided betwixt them. Item I giue to Will' Gent sunne of Will' Gent of overhulm the su'me of ten shilling I giue to John Bellfitt & ¹ his wife the su'me of ten shillings equally betwixt them I giue to the vicar of Leek to preach my funerall sermon ten shillings Item my will & mind is and I giue & bequeath to Will' Plant sonne of Will Plantt my nephew the su'me of forty pounds one half to become due out of the sume of Ninetey pound before mentioned & the other half out of ~~my~~ +the+ personall Estate I dye possesed of which s'd su'me of forty pounds the Interest thereof I gue to be bestowed of him toward^s the makeing him a scollar & the s'd su'me of forty +pounds+ to become due & payable when he shall accomplish the age of twenty & one Item my will & mind is & I giue & bequeath to y^e last mentioned Will' Plantt son to Will Plantt
